

police units were dispatched to the area of the Banyan Lakes apartment community located at 1651 Stonehaven Dr, Boynton Beach, FL in reference to shots being fired. Dispatch further advised approximately six to seven shots were fired from a vehicle. The suspect vehicle was described as dark colored van occupied by two black males. Upon arrival contact was made with witnesses who included Property Manager W/F Maria Estes DOB 04/20/1993 and Assistant Manager B/F Angeline Laurent DOB 09/18/1985. They stated that an occupant from the dark colored vehicle, later identified as a dark blue 2005 Dodge Caravan (FL Tag Z76B18), shot several times at the occupants/victims of a maroon vehicle identified as a 2017 Dodge Caravan (FL Tag DFRC64). The suspect vehicle left in a westbound direction while the victim vehicle left in an eastbound direction. This incident occurred in front of the Banyan Lakes manager's office that has a video surveillance camera pointing in the direction of where the incident took place. Also visible in the parking lot while we were on scene were six .380 caliber shell casings. Estes was able to remotely retrieve video surveillance from her phone where the incident was captured showing the vehicles facing each other as described above with the maroon Caravan driving around the suspect vehicle in an eastbound direction while the suspect vehicle leaves in a westbound direction.

The maroon Dodge caravan (victims' vehicle) returned to the scene with victims W/M Andre M Rodriguez DOB 05/23/1988 (driver) and B/M Marvin M Francois DOB 08/22/1994 (front passenger) providing sworn statements to this incident. Ofc. Jumelles collected verbal sworn statements utilizing her BWC with the following being synopsis and is not verbatim. Rodriguez confronted a child earlier in the day identified as B/M Bradley Calixte DOB 11/14/2008 because he had reportedly struck Rodriguez's Caravan with a stick. Rodriguez chased Bradley Calixte. Calixte returned to his apartment and told his mother, B/F Melisna Milliard DOB 06/24/1982, about the incident. Also at the home was the father, B/M Andre Calixte DOB 10/06/1982, who heard about the incident as well. Milliard and Calixte confronted Rodriguez about chasing their son near the apartments west of the crime scene and within 0.5 miles. Words were exchanged where the incident became more heated. Rodriguez left in his vehicle and noticed Anderson Calixte following him in the dark blue Caravan that was also occupied with another B/M, subsequently identified as VLADIMIR J FAREAU DOB 10/13/1981. Rodriguez picked up his friend Marvin Francois as they reached the front office area. The blue Caravan arrives and appears to try to box them in with the attempt of keeping them from leaving. Fareau then exits the vehicle and begins firing rounds at their vehicle. Rodriguez drives off as Francois ducks in the vehicle to avoid being shot as they drive away. Several defects from apparent gunshots were visible to the passenger side of the victims' Caravan. I observed four defects with indentations showing trajectories traveling from the right rear side and into the vehicle. Two defects were visible to the right rear passenger sliding door and one defect was on the front passenger door handle. Another defect was observed where it struck the windshield on the passenger side with entrance on the inside of the windshield, exiting outward.

A passenger would most likely have been struck if sitting upright in the front passenger seat. No injuries were suffered by either Rodriguez or Francois who were however visibly shaken.

Contact was made with Milliard near her residence of 1770 Stonehaven Drive along with her two children, Bradley Calixte and B/M Brandon Calixte DOB 09/13/2012. Milliard also gave a sworn statement corroborating the confrontation that had taken place with Rodriguez involving her son, Bradley. She also provided basic information for Anderson Calixte and the first name for Vladimir. She also stated they had left in a dark blue Dodge Caravan that belonged to an unknown person. She added that 'Vladimir' has been friends with Anderson Calixte for quite some time, that he has been to their apartment numerous times in the past and described him in the same manner as the victims. She agreed to come to the BBPD for further interviews in attempts to identify 'Vladimir' and speak with her husband to see if he would agree to arrive at the station for an interview. A DAVID photo was produced after database reviews produced the name of VLADIMIR J FAREAU DOB 10/13/1981. Milliard stated this in fact looked like the 'Vladimir' she was speaking of. Photo line-ups were prepared including Fareau to be presented to both Rodriguez and Francois. Ofc. Vasquez, unfamiliar with the suspect in this investigation, presented the photo line-ups to both victims Francois and Rodriguez. Both provided sworn independent positive identifications for Fareau as the shooter of this incident.

Contact was made with Anderson Calixte telephonically who agreed to meet with us for an interview. Anderson Calixte arrived at the BBPD driving the dark blue Caravan described above. The vehicle matched the vehicle from the video surveillance including the rims, the particular color, style and dark tinted windows. Det. Joseph and I interviewed Calixte where he was also presented a photo line-up including Fareau. Given that Calixte informed us he has known Fareau for seven to eight years and interacts with him in a social setting on a constant basis, instructions were not read to him and he was asked to point out Fareau if he was in the line-up. Calixte identified him without hesitation. Calixte also provided a sworn statement outlining the same facts given by others in this narrative. He added he was not aware if Fareau was in possession of a firearm. He remembers the confrontation in the parking lot where Fareau exited the vehicle to confront Rodriguez and Francois, but claims he did not witness Fareau fire a gun at the other car while he was out of the vehicle. Calixte stated he heard the gunshots and Fareau only said after re-entering the car that, "they bucked". Calixte drove off as described from the video surveillance and left the community where he dropped off Fareau at a 7-11 store close by. He could not tell us where to find Fareau or of his current whereabouts.

An F/NCIC search revealed Fareau has a criminal history including 26 felony charges and 36 misdemeanor charges. Four of the felony charges resulted in convictions with one showing a conviction date of May 27, 2008 for Possession of Cocaine. He was credited with 157 days in jail.

Based on all of the aforementioned fact there is probable cause to charge VLADIMIR J FAREAU with the following crimes.
SHOOTING INTO OCCUPIED VEHICLE FAREAU did wantonly or maliciously shoot at, within, or into a vehicle which was being used or occupied by Andre Rodriguez and Marvin Francois, contrary to Florida Statute 790.19.
ATTEMPTED FIRST DEGREE MURDER WITH A FIREARM (premeditated) FAREAU did unlawfully attempt to commit First Degree Murder, an offense prohibited by law, and in such attempt did an act toward the commission of such offense by shooting Andre Rodriguez and Marvin Francois but FAREAU failed in the perpetration or was intercepted or prevented in the execution of said offense, and during the commission or attempt to commit any offense listed in Florida Statute 775.087(2)(a)1 FAREAU actually possessed a firearm or destructive device as those terms are defined in section 790.001, Florida Statutes, and further during the course of committing or attempting to commit any offense listed in Florida Statute 775.087(2)(a)1, FAREAU discharged a firearm or destructive device as defined in section 790.001, Florida Statutes, and, as the result of the discharge, death or great bodily harm was inflicted upon Andre Rodriguez and Marvin Francois, contrary to Florida Statutes 777.04(1) and 782.04(1)(a)(1) and 775.087(1) and (2). (LIFE FEL)

FELON IN POSSESSION OF FIREARM OR AMMUNITION (Actual Possession) did, after having been convicted of a felony in the courts of Florida, or after having been convicted of or found to have committed a crime against the United States which is designated as a felony, or having been found guilty of an offense that is a felony in another state, territory or country and which was punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, unlawfully own or have care, custody, actual possession, or control of a firearm, ammunition or electric weapon or device contrary to Florida Statute 775.087(2) and 790.23(1)(a),(c),(d)and(e). (2 DEG FEL)
