<p>On 09-10-18 I responded to the Ouzo Bay restaurant / bar located at 201 Plaza Real in reference to a report of a suspicious incident. Upon arriving at the restaurant I met with BRPD Officer Douglas Crowe. Officer Crowe told me that at approximately 9:05pm he responded to Ouzo Bay and met with the manager of the restaurant, Brian Bagley. It was reported that a customer at the establishment had observed a male customer at the bar pour a powder like substance in to a females drink while the female had left the bar to go to the restroom.</p> <p>Manager Brian Bagley reported that he was alerted by a customer, later identified as Huguette Lorzeil, that she observed a customer later identified as, Mircea Morariu, pour a powder like substance into a females drink while she was in the restroom. The female that left Morariu's company to use the restroom was later identified as, Jeannette Schroeder. Bagley stated that bartender Marco Leo, was alerted that Morariu was observed pouring the powder into Schroeder's drink by Lorzeil who was also sitting at the bar. Bagley stated that Leo had brought the glass to him. After observing the glass, Bagley saw a powdery substance at the bottom and around the rim. Officer Crowe observed the glass as well and noticed the same powdery substance in the glass and at the bottom of the drink.</p> <p>Officer Crowe met with Jeannette Schroeder who was standing at the front door of the restaurant with another manager by the name of Laura Euron. Boca Raton Fire Rescue responded to check on Schroeder as she was observed by Lorzeil consuming the drink with the unknown powder substance inside of it. Schroeder was subsequently transported to Boca Raton Regional Hospital.</p> <p>BRPD Sergeant Seth Dubinsky and Officer Crowe made contact with Morariu as he was exiting the restroom. Officer Crowe read Morariu his constitutional warnings from a pre-printed department issued Miranda card. Sergeant Dubinsky questioned Morariu.</p>

P R O B A B L E C A U S E S T A T E M E N T	<p>Morariu denied that he put a powdery substance in Schroeder's drink. Morariu refused to answer any other questions. Morariu was released from the scene prior to my arrival at the restaurant.</p> <p>Sergeant Dubinsky and Officer Derek Mazer checked the men's restroom. Sergeant Dubinsky located and collected a clear plastic bag with a white powder residue inside that was found in the trash within the restroom.</p> <p>BRPD Detective Darryl Kingman responded to the restaurant and collected video surveillance. The video surveillance captures Schroeder, Morariu and Lorzeil at the bar. Schroeder and Morariu are seen talking and at one point Schroeder walks away from the bar towards the restroom. Upon closer examination of the video it appears as though Morariu reaches into his back pocket while alone at the bar however due to video technical difficulties the video pauses and it does not capture Morariu pouring anything into Schroeder's drink.</p> <p>BRPD Crime Scene Technician Dawn McDonald responded to the restaurant and processed the scene. CST McDonald collected the martini glass with the white powder residue as well as the clear plastic baggie collected by Sergeant Dubinsky. CST McDonald also responded to the hospital and collected urine and blood from Schroeder. Refer to CST McDonald's supplemental report for complete details.</p> <p>I responded to the Boca Raton Regional Hospital and met with Jeanette Schroeder. I attempted to obtain a statement from Schroeder however due to Schroeder's slightly incoherent condition I was unable to obtain one. I made arrangements with hospital staff to collect a blood and urine sample from Schroeder which was facilitated through CST McDonald.</p> <p>During the course of this investigation I requested that the clear plastic baggie and the martini glass recovered from the bar be processed for latent prints. Although several latent prints were recovered they remain unidentified. Arrangements were made to have the clear plastic zip lock bag, the martini glass and Schroeder's blood and urine to be sent to the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office Crime Lab for analysis.</p> <p>On 09-14-18 I met with Jeanette Schroeder and Schroeder's attorney, Susan Ramsey at the Boca Raton Police Department. Schroeder provided a sworn video recorded statement. In summary, Schroeder told me that she had recently reconnected with Mircea Morariu whom she had known through mutual friends for almost twenty years. Schroeder stated that she agreed to meet with Morariu at Ouzo Bay to discuss the fact that Morariu had just gotten engaged to a person that Schroeder thought that Morariu was no longer in a relationship with. Schroeder stated that she arrived at the bar alone and had not consumed any alcohol or drugs prior to arriving. Morariu was already at the bar. They ordered drinks</p>

P	<p>and some food. A short time later they ordered a second round of drinks. At one point after having been served the second drink Schroeder excused herself to use the restroom. When she returned from the restroom she stated that Morariu was pushing her drink towards her and that he had moved her water glass away. Schroeder stated that Morariu wanted her to finish her drink. Schroeder stated that she continued drinking the martini. Morariu went to the bathroom and while Morariu was in the restroom a Boca Raton Police Officer approached her and asked her to step outside the bar. Schroeder stated that she had no idea what was going on and was shocked to hear that Morariu was observed pouring a powder into her drink. Fire Rescues had responded and assessed Schroeder. Schroeder stated that she initially did not want to go to the hospital to get checked out however based on the Officer's and Fire Rescues advice she decided to go.</p>							
R	<p>On 09-21-18 I responded to 15950 SW 7th St in Pembroke Pines Florida and met with Hugnette Lorzeil. I obtained a sworn recorded statement from Lorzeil. In summary, Lorzeil told me that she observed a male subject at the bar with a female. Lorzeil stated that she was sitting close to them at the bar. Lorzeil stated that she observed the male subject pull a clear plastic baggie out of his pocket and pour a white powder into his hand. The subject then poured the powder into the females drink while the female was using the restroom. Lorzeil stated that the male subject attempted to stir the drink. Lorzeil observed the female return to the bar and consume the drink. Lorzeil was concerned for the females' safety and left the bar. Once outside of the bar she called the bar from her cell phone and informed the management about what she had observed. Refer to the complete audio recorded statement for complete details.</p>							
A	<p>On 09-23-18 the Palm Beach County Forensic Sciences Division drafted a chemistry report in reference to the clear plastic Ziploc bag containing a white residue and a clear martini glass containing a white residue that had been sent to the lab for forensic testing. The results indicated that the Ziploc bag contained residue of Zolpidem and Alprazolam both of which are schedule IV drugs. Zolpidem residue was also located in the martini glass. Refer to PBSO case # 18-011787 for details.</p>							
B	<p>On 10-23-18 the Palm Beach County Forensic Sciences Division drafted a toxicology report in reference to the blood alcohol and urine kit obtained from Jeanette Schroeder that had been sent to the lab for testing. The report noted that Schroeder's blood alcohol and drug analysis contained Ethanol, Benzoylcegonine (cocaine metabolite), Alprazolam and Zolpidem. Schroeder's urine drug analysis contained Cocaine, Benzoylcegonine, Alprazolam, Alpha-hydroxyalprazolam and Zolpidem. Refer to PBSO case # 18-011787 for details.</p>							
C	<p>On 10-29-18 I spoke with PBSO Toxicology Manager Nicholas Tiscione. Tiscione had drafted the toxicology report. Tiscione was able to clarify the results. I learned that the cocaine levels detected were low. The blood alcohol was consistent with consuming a few</p>

<p>mixed drinks. The levels of Alprazolam and Zolpidem were noted as being lower than in the therapeutic range. Tiscione told me that the combination of Alcohol, Alprazolam and Zolpidem would be consistent with becoming sleepy and possibly passing out. I later spoke with Jeanette Schroeder and reviewed the results of the toxicology. In summary, Schroeder told me that she did use a small amount of cocaine approximately one week prior to this incident. Schroeder told me that she has a prescription for Xanax (Alprazolam) and last took some within a day or two of this incident. Schroeder told me that she is not prescribed nor had taken Zolpidem or any of its generic forms.</p> <p>Mircea Morariu was observed by witness Huguette Lorzeil pour a white powder into Jeanette Schroeder's martini glass while Schroeder was using the restroom. Lorzeil observed Schroeder consume the drink contaminated by the white powder and contacted bar management to inform the bar of her observations. The bar contacted the police. BRPD Officers and Crime Scene Technicians recovered a Ziploc bag and the martini glass that Schroeder was drinking from. Both items contained a white powder residue. The powder was later forensically tested and determined to be a combination of Alprazolam and Zolpidem. Both are schedule IV controlled drugs.</p> <p>Mircea Morariu is charged with poisoning food or water contrary to FSS 859.01.</p>
