On 12/19/18 at about 0344 hours Boca Raton Police Department road patrol officers responded to 498 NE 25th Terrrace, Boca Raton in reference to a domestic disturbance. A white, female, later identified as Bonnie Long called stating her husband, white, male David Long, struck her in the face and threatened her with a machete.

Upon Officer Forbes' arrival, Bonnie Long was waiting at the Pollo Tropical, 2401 N. Federal Hwy., which is just east of her residence. Bonnie told Ofc. Forbes that David punched her in the right side of her face, near her chin and threatened her with a machete. Ofc. Forbes said at this point he saw that David Long's truck was running in the middle of the street near the residence where Bonnie implied David had driven the truck and also brought an unknown black male to the residence.

Officers Forbes and Tyson then went to the residence, 498 NE 25th Terrrace to speak with David Long. As officers approached the front of the residence, the front door was completely open, however they did not see any movement inside through the front windows or open door. They called to David Long several times but he did not exit the home at this time. OfficerTyson said he held a position at the front of the residence where he could see into the open door while Officers Bohan and Forbes cleared Long's truck which was still in the roadway. The truck was unoccupied except for a large breed dog inside. After determining the truck was clear of any persons, Officers Bohan and Forbes returned to the front of the home where Ofc. Tyson was standing by. As Ofc. Forbes walked closer to the threshold of the door calling for David, David replied from an unknown location within the residence stating he was coming out. David approached officers near the front door with his hands up. He was compliant and sat on a couch in the living room just inside the front door. Ofc. Tyson later stated he immediately smelled a strong odor of unburt marijuana upon entering the front door to speak with David.

Because officers had gathered information that a black male may also be present, Ofcs. Tyson and Forbes conducted a protective sweep of the home to ensure no one else was inside and to ensure no one was in need of immediate or medical assistance. While conducting the sweep it was determined that no other persons were inside the home, however in the northwest bedroom officers what they stated appeared to be a "growhouse". The room contained approximately seventeen marijuana plants in black buckets with watering hoses attached to each one, fans and humidity controls. Officers Tyson and Forbes both stated the odor of marijuana near this room was extremely strong and once the room was cleared of any persons the door was closed and they continued their protective sweep. It should be noted that Ofc. Tyson stated during the protective sweep he notice several items of drug paraphernalia in plain view throughout the house.

After interviewing both Bonnie and David, Officer Forbes did not make any arrests. He noted that both parties had inconsistant and conflicting statements, no injuries, there were no witnesses and probable cause could not be established reference the domestic violence case. Ofc. Tyson provided Bonnie with a domestic violence packet as well as BRPD case number 2018-17123.

At about 0530 hours I spoke with Bonnie Long in the parking lot of the Pollo Tropical. I read Bonnie her consistutional rights from a pre-printed card which she verbally stated she understood. She told me she has been married to David for twenty-seven year and has lived at the home at 498 NE 25th Terrace for about fifteen years. She said she has been having domestic problems with David recently, however she still calls the residence home and has stayed there for the past two days. When I asked Bonnie if there were any drugs or anything illegal inside the home she hesitated then replied "no". When I explained that officers located marijuana growing inside she said she was unaware of it. I asked how she could possibly be inside the home and not notice the overpowering smell of marijuana to which she shrugged her shoulders as if to impy she didn't know. Bonnie said David does smoke marijuana inside the home so she thought it was just from that. She told me she sleeps on the east side of the home and was not aware of anything in the west bedrooms. Without prompting she also specifically stated she was not aware of anything inside the garage or shed.

I then spoke with david Long who was sitting just outside his residence. I read David his consititutional rights from a pre-printed card which he verbally stated he understood. David told me he and Bonnie live inside the home with their four dogs. He said they having been having some problems, however Bonnie has stayed at the home the past "couple nights". I asked if he was aware of the marijuana growing inside the northwest bedroom. He told me Bonnie has a medical marijuana card, however he did not. David then suggested that he was aware of the plants but that they belonged to Bonnie. I asked David if he assisted Bonnie with caring for the plants in the room. He shook his head up and down as if to respond yes, then stated "there are only seventeen plants", he then stopped speaking. I asked David if he wished to remain silent and he

responded "yes". It should be noted that while speaking with David at the front door of the home, which was open, I could smell an extremely strong odor of what I know based on my training and experience is unburnt marijuana.

Investigation revealed David and Bonnie Long are the only two owners listed for 498 NE 25th Terrace, Boca Raton.

On 12/19/18 at about 0910 hours the Honorable Judge August Bonavita signed a search warrant for the property located at 498 NE 25th Terrace. The following items were located in the home:

Inside the east bedroom (labeled room B) was one vape pen vape pen, which later tested positive for THC (25.2 grams), an expired drivers license belonging to David Long, \$500 US Currency and one jar of marijuana, later tested positive (285 grams). Inside the kitchen (room C) was a vape pen containing an unknown liquid. A large bag of various ammunition was located in the southwest bedroom (room F). The northwest bedroom (room G) contained eighteen marijuana plants, later tested positive (total weight 22.41 pounds), several buckets, venilation systems, thermometer, humidity control, lights and other items related to the growing and cultivation of marijuana. The marijuana plants and samples of the grow equipment were collected. The remaining equipment was rendered inoperable. It should be noted that lights, venilation equipment and other various items associated with growing marijuana were located within several of the bedrooms, rear porch and shed in the fenced in back yard. A number of garbage bags outside the home also contained what appeared to be marijauna clippings.

Based on the above information, David Long was arrested and charged in violation of FSS 893.13(1A2) for knowingly manufacturing cannabis, commonly refered to as marijuana, a controlled substance and FSS 893.135(1) for owning a structure to be used for the manufacture of a controlled substance as provided in 893.13.

Long was taken into custody by Officer McCabe and transported the the BRPD booking facility, he was later turned over to the PBCJ.

At this time there is also probable cause for the arrest of Bonnie Long reference violation of FSS 893.13(1A2) for knowingly manufacturing cannabis, commonly refered to as marijuana, a controlled substance and FSS 893.135(1) for owning a structure to be used for the manufacture of a controlled substance as provided in 893.13.
