On January 10th, 2020 at 1011 hours, the Boca Raton Police Department Dispatch center received a 911 call from (754) 204-8792. The caller identified himself as Jarvis and stated that there was an armed robbery that took place at 1401 NW 14th Avenue in the city of Boca Raton. Officer Madotta (ID number 842) and Officer Schuss (ID 725) Boca Raton Police Department (BRPD) responded to 1401 NW 14th Avenue in the city of Boca Raton in refence to this armed robbery.

Officers arrived on scene and performed a protective sweep of the residence to secure the crime scene and locate any other victims. Officers talked with Sharon Polnac, Jarett Polnac, Ryan Machado, and Jarvis Jordan at the scene. Officers were able to confirm a robbery had taken place, but the above individuals gave conflicting statements about what was taken and descriptions of the offenders. While inside the residence, responding Officers also detected the odor of marijuana. Initially, all the above individuals told responding detectives they were present for the robbery and that Sharon Polnac and Jarett Polnac both reside at the residence.

Boca Raton Police Department Detectives responded to the scene to handle the investigation. Detective Derstine (ID 653) completed a walkthrough of the residence with Jarett Polnac to document the events of the robbery and discover what items were missing. Jarett Polnac stated that two firearms were stolen during the robbery. During the walk through, Detective Derstine observed a white powdery substance on the glass living room table. Also located on the table was a tan towel that had a black remote holder placed on top of it. The tan towel had marijuana residue and a white powder that field tested positive for cocaine. Upon further investigation, the black remote holder had an open drawer with a glass vial filled with an unknown white substance. Detective Derstine did not disturb the glass vial and asked Jarett Polnac where the gun was located when it was stolen. Polnac pointed to a console in the middle of one of the

couches in the living room. Detective Derstine asked Jarett Polnac if anyone checked if the gun was still there and Jarett stated no one checked. Detective Derstine then lifted the console and confirmed the gun was missing. While lifting the console, Detective Derstine observed a small capsule which contained a brown substance that resembled heroin based on his training and experience.

Detective Derstine observed a tissue box between the two couches. In plain view, inside the empty tissue box was a prescription pill bottle containing an unknown type of prescription pill. The prescription label was not visible and could not be viewed without manipulating the box. Also, in the tissue box was a clear baggie with multiple thin rectangular prescription tablets which appeared to be Xanax based on Detective Derstine's training and experience. Detective Derstine also observed other small clear sandwich baggies with various narcotics inside the tissue box but did not manipulate the tissue box. It should be noted that this is not a common way for law abiding citizens to store prescription pills and is usually observed in narcotics sales.

Detective Derstine also observed a plastic zip lock baggy with a green leafy substance on the floor next to the sofa perpendicular to the other sofa mentioned above and next to the tissue box. The green substance was field tested and tested positive for marijuana. Jarett Polnac also pointed out two long guns were still located in an air-conditioning utility closet. Sharon Polnac was later asked about the drugs and she stated she did not know there were drugs inside the house and asked, "Who put them there?" Jarett Polnac was also asked about the narcotics and he stated he did not put the drugs there and many people hang out inside his residence who liked to party.

On February 10th, 2020, Warrant number BRPS\_202\_000002 was signed by the honorable Judge Kathleen Knoll and was executed on February 10th, 2020 by members of the Boca Raton Police Department Vice, Intelligence, and Narcotics Unit (VIN). The warrant was obtained after Detectives and Officers of the Boca Raton Police Department observed narcotics in plain view at 1401 NW 14th Ave in the city of Boca Raton during an armed home invasion investigation. The search warrant yielded, 1.93 pounds of Marijuana, 69.5 pills of Alprazolam, 10.7 grams of cocaine, 94 boxes of pre-rolled marijuana cigarettes, 10 packs of THC cartridges, 19 jars of edible marijuana, drug ledger, black scale, money counter and 4 juvenile marijuana plants. Your affiant believes that the items found inside the residence is indicative of narcotics sale and/or narcotics trafficking.

On June 03, 2020, the honorable Carolyn Bell of the 15th Judicial Circuit signed a warrant authorizing the search and seizure of the cell phone belonging to Jarett Polnac that was located during a search warrant of 1401 NW 14th Avenue (Warrant number RPS\_2020\_000041).

Detective Melgar (ID 705) was supplied a copy of the warrant and the application to forensically examine the white Apple Iphone. After the examination was complete

Detective Melgar supplied me with a digital copy of the evidence located on the cell phone.

I reviewed the information that was located on the cell phone. It should be noted that one of the last photos taken on the cell phone was of Jarret Polnac and the duct tape that was used to restrain him. The picture was a selfie taken in the bathroom where the cell phone was located during the search warrant. This evidence indicates that the cell phone belongs to Jarrett Polnac and was the cell phone seized in the bathroom.

It should be indicated that all the text messages in the cell phone were deleted to hide any evidence that may have been located on the phone. During the forensic analysis, the deleted text messages were recovered from the cell phone and the messages were a clear indication of activity indictive of drug sales.

Furthermore, the pictures that were taken utilizing the cell phone camera captured the bedspread and numerous large vacuum sealed bags of marijuana. The vacuum bags of marijuana resembled the ones that were seized in the search warrant and the bedspread in the picture matched the bedspread on Jarett Polnac`s bed. This confirms that the pictures of the suspected marijuana that were found during the search warrant were taken in Jarett`s bedroom. There were numerous pictures of cash, ledgers and narcotics indicating that Jarett Polnac has been involved in illegal narcotics transactions.

Assistant State Attorney Elizabeth Neto authorized the testing of the suspected marijuana that was seized during the search warrant. The Palm Beach County Crime Laboratory, Forensic Sciences Division initiated a case number 20-11071. Two submissions were supplied to the laboratory but only one (1) submission was tested. Submission one was 3 plastic bags containing a green colored leaf material. The bags weighed a total amount of 141.20 grams and tested positive as marijuana. It should be noted that the lower threshold for the laboratory is one percent (1%) of Tetrahydrocannabinol which is higher than the 0.3% legal limit.

On November 11, 2020 around 1300 hours, Detective Cerami and I traveled to 1401 NW 14th Ave in the City of Boca Raton Florida to talk to Jarett Polnac about the narcotics found inside his residence during a search warrant. Prior to our arrival, Officer Derstine contacted Jarett Polnac outside his residence walking a dog. Officer Derstine informed Jarret that detectives were arriving to speak with him. I previously called Jarett and informed him that we needed to arrange to release his property to him from the search warrant. Jarett requested that we meet him at the house around 1400 hours. Officer Derstine left the area after we arrived to talk with Jarett.

Detective Cerami and I approached Jarett and introduced ourselves. I informed Jarett that we were there to talk about the search warrant and the investigation. Jarett stated he would talk to us about the items found inside his residence. The conversation

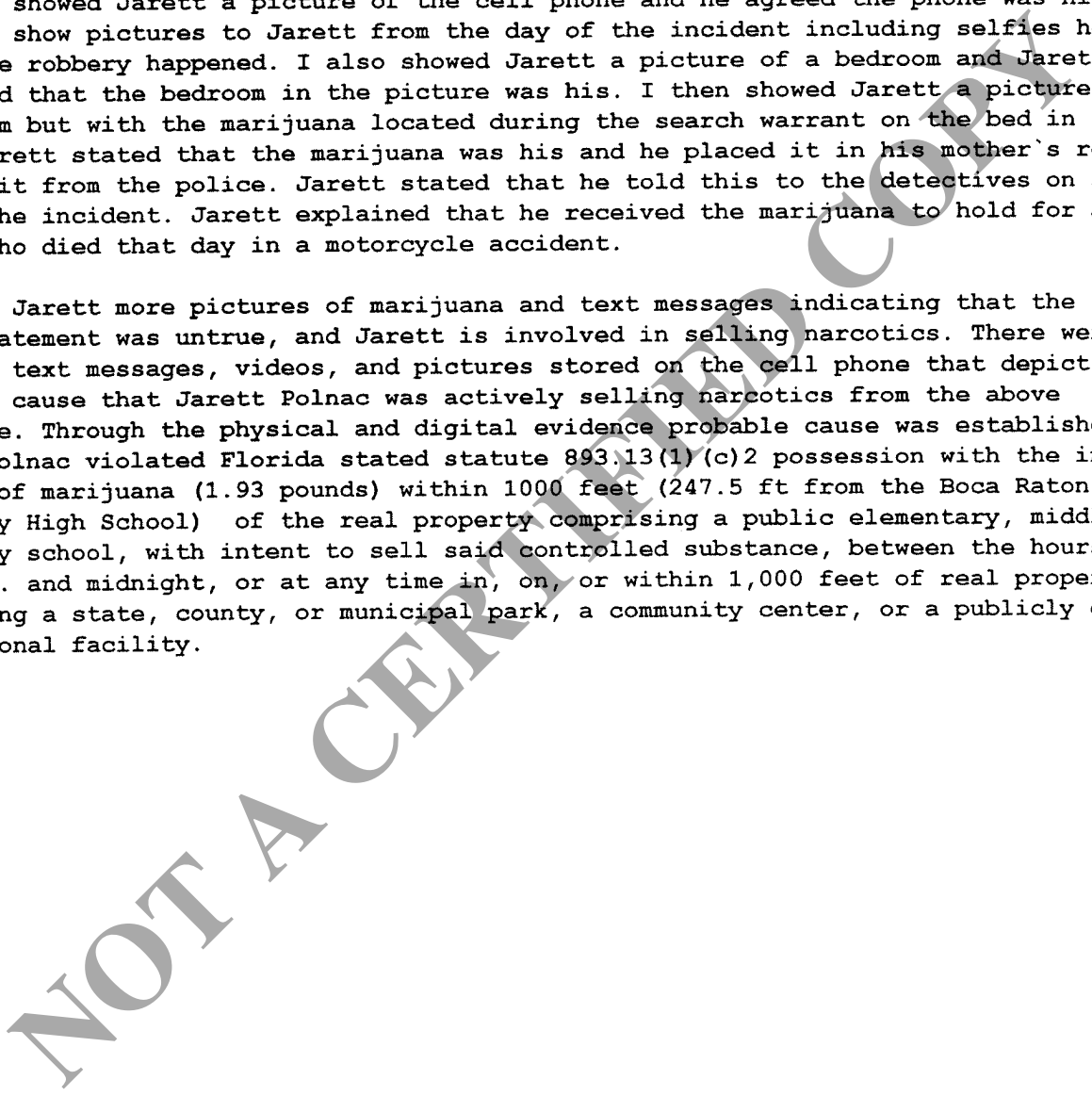

was taking place on the sidewalk in front of Jarett's residence. Jarett had the opportunity to walk away from us and the path to his residence was never blocked. Jarett understood that he was free to walk away anytime he wanted.

I informed Jarrett that a warrant was applied for and granted to search his cell phone. I showed Jarett a picture of the cell phone and he agreed the phone was his. I began to show pictures to Jarett from the day of the incident including selfies he took after the robbery happened. I also showed Jarett a picture of a bedroom and Jarett confirmed that the bedroom in the picture was his. I then showed Jarett a picture of the same room but with the marijuana located during the search warrant on the bed in the room. Jarett stated that the marijuana was his and he placed it in his mother's room to conceal it from the police. Jarett stated that he told this to the detectives on scene during the incident. Jarett explained that he received the marijuana to hold for a friend who died that day in a motorcycle accident.

I showed Jarett more pictures of marijuana and text messages indicating that the above statement was untrue, and Jarett is involved in selling narcotics. There were numerous text messages, videos, and pictures stored on the cell phone that depict probable cause that Jarett Polnac was actively selling narcotics from the above residence. Through the physical and digital evidence probable cause was established that Jarett Polnac violated Florida stated statute 893.13(1)(c)2 possession with the intent of sale of marijuana (1.93 pounds) within 1000 feet (247.5 ft from the Boca Raton Community High School) of the real property comprising a public elementary, middle, or secondary school, with intent to sell said controlled substance, between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and midnight, or at any time in, on, or within 1,000 feet of real property comprising a state, county, or municipal park, a community center, or a publicly owned recreational facility.
