On the 2 day of August, 2023 at 14:45 (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

On July 21, 2023, Delray Beach Police received a call from a subject that stated he located a suitcase on the west side of the intra-coastal waterway that he believed contained human remains. Detectives responded to the area and observed a suitcase with a human foot protruding through the zipper. Upon opening the suitcase (suitcase # 1), it was discovered that the suitcase contained to human legs. There were several small landscaping rocks in the suitcase. The suitcase had what appeared to be an airlines barcode sticker. The sticker read the following "Latam, MIA, Barbosa (Unidentified Character) Ontes /A

Approximately one hour later Delray Beach Police received a second call from a second witness stating that they had located a suitcase on the rocks, on the west side of the intra-coastal waterway that contained human remains. Detectives responded to the area and observed the contents of the suitcase (suitcase # 2) to be a human torso. The torso was missing the head and the hands and ended just below the stomach area. There were several small landscaping rocks in the suitcase.

While on scene the witness stated his friend was on a boat in the area and had located a third suitcase caddy corner (east side of intra-coastal) and further south from the location that detectives were currently at. The subject advised that they believed the suitcase contained human remains. Detectives responded to the area and located a suitcase (suitcase # 3) which contained a human female pelvis. The suitcase contained a bag (Cheesecake Factory) containing multiple landscaping rocks and barnacles as well as several loose large size barnacles within the suitcase.

On July 22, 2023, a multi-agency marine operation was conducted in the intra-coastal waterway in the city of Delray Beach. A Coast Guard vessel containing a Delray Beach detective, located a "Tote" type bag that was tied shut around the handles with twine. The bag (Bag #1) had what appeared to be a men's belt wrapped around it. The bag

contained a female human head. It should be noted that detectives and Delray Beach CSI observed a single gunshot wound behind the victim's ear with an exit wound behind the opposite ear. The Medical Examiner later determined the manner of death to be homicide, and cause of death to be a gunshot wound to the head.

As the search continued, members of the Delray Beach Underwater Search & Recovery Team located a purse (Bag #2) slightly north of the above-mentioned bag. This purse was tied shut with the same type of twine used on the above-mentioned bag. The purse contained an ashtray (which may have been used as a weight) and had a decomposition odor.

On July 23, 2023, Detective Liberta and Detective Vickery met with a witness (Martin Maxwell & Denise Maxwell) who reside in the near vicinity (917 Bucida Rd Unit C) of the location that Suitcase #3 was found. The witness stated that they saw the suitcase on the south side of the waterway prior to Detectives locating the suitcase on the north side of the waterway. The witness advised that for several days prior to 07/21/23 they observed a W/M approximately in his 50's-60s looking into the intra-costal waterway. They stated he appeared to be looking at the suitcase. The subject was seen by the witness approximately 5-6 times over a three-day period. The witness advised that he made contact with the subject and asked him what he was looking at. The subject advised he was "waiting for the big boat to come into the harbor". The witness told the subject that no big boats come into the harbor it is too shallow. He then asked the subject which boat he was waiting for, and the subject pointed to a boat across the waterway and stated, "a boat like that". The witness stated the subject appeared nervous and immediately walked over to his car (older model gold sedan), entered it, and left the area.

While in the area speaking with witnesses Detective Liberta noticed a metal dock ladder in the vicinity of the area that Suitcase #3 was located. Upon examining the ladder Detective Liberta noticed it appeared that the bottom step was completely free of barnacles however the step above the bottom step was covered in barnacles. Detective Liberta requested DBPD CSI respond to the area and process the ladder for latent prints and other forensic evidence. CSI Investigator Thompson responded and processed the ladder and recovered a substance she believed to be blood. After further testing, the results yielded a positive finding for blood.

On July 24, 2023, Detective Liberta and Detective Vickery made contact with three subjects (Francisco Simeon, Ledin Eclices & Miguel Manuel Lopex) that were currently working on a roof of a property (500 Oleander Dr) parallel to the location where Suitcase # 3 was located. The witnesses advised that they had seen the suitcases in the waterway. They stated it was apparent, based on the odor, that there was some type of remains in the suitcase. They advised that on 07/21/23 they observed a W/M and provided the same physical description and vehicle description as the above witness; they further advised the vehicle was a Ford. The witnesses stated the subject was standing on the

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seawall looking at the suitcase. The witnesses advised they heard the subject say "SHIT", at which point he immediately entered his vehicle and left the area.



On July 24, 2023, Detective Liberta and Detective Vickery met with additional witnesses (David Colburn & Kathleen Colburn) that stated on 07/20/23 they observed a W/M (same physical description and vehicle description as the above witnesses) on the dock of the residence that was having the roof replaced. They advised that they observed the subject enter the waterway using the metal dock ladder on this property. They stated the subject had what appeared to be a brush on a metal pole in his hand. The witness stated they observed what appeared to be the subject attempting to push or scrape something in the waterway (using the brush in a downward motion).

On July 30, 2023, Det. Lunsford was reviewing video surveillance from 500 Oleander Dr and observed a W/M with gray hair, climb down the resident's dock ladder at 7:04 AM on 07/20/23. The subject then climbs back up the ladder and walks out of the area of the surveillance. The same video then reveals the same subject climb down the dock ladder at 4:13 PM on 07/20/23. The subject was not wearing a shirt and carrying what appeared to be a Cheesecake Factory Bag (the bag appeared to have some type of weight to it). The subject was also holding what appeared to be a metal pole. The subject climbs down the ladder at which time he is not able to be seen by video surveillance. The subject then reappears in the frame as he climbs up the dock ladder at 4:19 PM and is no longer in possession of the bag. The subject immediately removes his shoes and exits the frame. A pair of shoes was recovered in the same area by Delray Beach Police CSI.

On July 31, 2023, Det. Caceres advised me that on 07/24/23 at 11:30 AM while BOLOing the area of the crime scene he noticed a gold Ford Taurus in the area and took a picture of the vehicles tag (FL Tag DV0355L). Detectives ran the vehicles tag, and the results yielded the following: 2008 Ford 4 DR registered to William P Lowe Jr., DOB 03/28/1945. Lowe's address is 315 Venetian DR. Apt 4 in the city of Delray Beach. DAVID also revealed a 2nd vehicle registered to Lowe as a 2017 Dark Blue Subaru station wagon (FL Tag DV3361J). It should be noted that this location is 0.1 miles from the location that Suitcase # 3 was recovered and 0.3 miles from the dock ladder. Detectives then ran Lowe through DAVID and obtained a picture which showed Lowe as a white male with gray hair. Further investigation through DAVID revealed that a Hispanic female by the name of Aydil Barbosa Fontes also lived at 315 Venetian Dr. Apt 4. in the city of Delray Beach.

On 07/31/23 your Affiant authored a DNA search warrant for William Lowe. The warrant was granted by the Honorable Judge James Martz. On this same date Officers located Lowe and transported him back to the Delray Beach Police Department in order to execute the warrant. Post Miranda Lowe made the following statements:

Your Affiant confirmed that Lowe lived at 315 Venetian Dr. Apt 4. Lowe advised that he was married and stated that his wife's name was Aydil Barbosa Fontes. Your Affiant asked

<p> Lowe where his wife was, and he replied "In Brazil. When asked how long Barbosa has been in Brazil he stated, "about 3 weeks." Your Affiant asked Lowe how his wife got to the airport, and he advised he did not know. When asked what airline she flew, Lowe advised he did not know. Your Affiant asked Lowe when the last time he spoke with his wife and he replied, "I don't know." Your Affiant asked Lowe if he had fallen or cut himself recently and Lowe replied "other than shaving no." Your Affiant showed Lowe a picture of two of the suitcases that Barbosa was found in and asked Lowe if he had ever seen either suitcase. Lowe replied, "No Sir." Your Affiant asked Lowe why there would be a sticker on the suitcase related to his wife's name and he replied, "I don't know." </p> <p> On 07/31/23 your Affiant authored a search warrant for 315 Venetian Dr. Apt 4. The warrant was granted by the Honorable Judge James Martz. The warrant was executed on the same day. Upon execution of the warrant Detectives observed blood spatter throughout the residence to include the living room, dining room, hallway, both bathrooms and the master bedroom. Blood was detected in the master bath shower drain as well as the tub of the second bathroom. Drag marks were observed in the living room, hallway, and master bathroom. Large amounts of blood were found in the living room, dining room and master bathroom. Numerous cleaning supplies were found throughout the residence some containing blood spatter. </p> <p> While executing the search warrant Lowe returned to the residence and attempted to enter the residence through the rear window. Lowe was met by Officers and prevented from entering. Lowe stated that he was just trying to get his phone and the keys to his storage unit. Upon search of the spare bedroom detectives located a business card on for Security Storage of Delray located at 2900 Georgia St. in the City of Delray Beach. This desk is the same desk that Lowe requested your Affiant to locate his wallet and retrieve Lowe's credit card and driver's license. A 9mm firearm was located in the drawer of the same desk. </p> <p> On 07/31/2023 Detective Caceres met with Allison Lazarus at 315 Venetian Dr. Apt 1. Lazarus stated that she has been living in that apartment for over two years. Lazarus advised she knows her neighbors across the way in apartment 4 as Bill and his wife which she did not know how to pronounce her name and stated "Azul". Lazarus stated that earlier today at approximately 0800 hours, while she was walking her dogs, she observed Lowe putting a plastic container tote box into his tan vehicle. Lazarus stated that she last saw Barbosa a couple of weeks ago. Lazarus stated that her dogs would bark when they hear movement and recently, they have been barking between 0130-0330 hours in the morning and she would wake up from her sleep and hear Lowe's apartment door open and close which is unusual to her. Lazarus stated that Lowe sometimes leaves flowers in front of her door and most recently, last Wednesday 07/26/23, she saw flowers on her doorstep in the morning when she went to walk the dogs. Lazarus confirmed with Lowe via text message that he had left her flowers. Lazarus advised that the apartment above Lowe's is owned by Lowe's sister, but she has never seen her since Lazarus has lived </p>

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there. Lazarus stated has seen both Lowe and Barbosa go up to the apartment occasionally.

On 08/01/23 Dr. Miller of the Palm Beach County Medical Examiner's Office confirmed through dental records the identity of the decedent to be Aydil Barbosa Fontes.

On 08/01/23 your Affiant made contact with witness (upstairs neighbor Apt 4) Alexandria Ruggiero, who stated that the apartment across the hall from her is owned by Lowe's sister (Apt 8). She stated that she has not seen the sister in over two years, possibly three. She advised that she has seen Lowe on multiple occasions enter Apt. 8. Ruggiero said on average over the past three years she would say that Lowe enters Apt 4 approximately 1-2 times a month. She stated that Lowes stores items in the apartment and she thinks he may use the refrigerator as well. Ruggiero advised that at times Lowes leaves the keys to the apartment in the door, but she never says anything because he later returns and retrieves the keys. Ruggiero recalled an incident that was approximately two-three weeks prior where she had seen what she thought was a trail of "soup" leading from the door of Apt 4 through the hallway, up the stairs to the door of Apt 8. I made contact with the Jonathan Raush, who is in charge of property maintenance who confirmed Ruggiero's statement. Raush stated that he cleaned the stained trail using "409" cleaning agent. Raush could not give me an exact date of when this occurred but thought that it was approximately three weeks prior to today's date.

On 08/01/23 your Affiant observed the front door of 315 Venetian Dr. Apt. 8 in the city of Delray Beach and it should be noted that attached to the front door of this apartment is a metal plaque engraved with "The Bill Lowes". It should also be noted on this same date Delray Beach Police Department CSI Karla Del Valle observed what appeared to be blood spatter on the wall next to the entry door of Apt. 8.

On 08/01/23 your Affiant authored a search warrant for 315 Venetian Dr. Apt 8. The warrant was granted by the Honorable Judge James Martz. The warrant was executed on the same day. Upon execution of the warrant Detectives observed a black cover for a Ryobi chain saw on the dining room table as well as a Ryobi charger which would be used to charge the battery on the chainsaw. Multiple bottles of cleaning supplies were found in this apartment as well.

On 08/02/23 Det. Vickery and Det. Carceres made contact with the property manager at Security Storage of Delray and confirmed that Lowe in fact had a storage unit at this facility. The unit # was 88. On this same date Det. Lunsford authored a search warrant for the storage unit located at 2900 Georgia St. Unit 88. The warrant was granted by the Honorable Judge James Martz. The warrant was executed on the same day. Upon execution of the warrant Detectives located a Ryobi chainsaw that appeared to have blood on the blade, chain and housing. Detectives observed what appeared to be bone matter, flesh and human hair in the housing of the saw. Also located in the unit was a small Coleman

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

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cooler located next to the chainsaw. The cooler appeared to have red marks on the cover as well as red stains in the cooler. Detectives believe these marks and stains to be blood. The box that the chainsaw was purchased in was also present. Correspondence for Lowe was located in the storage unit.

Based on the above facts, Probable Cause exists to charge the defendant, William P. Lowe Jr. with First Degree Murder in violation of F.S.S. 782.02(1)(A)(2) & Abuse of a Dead Human Body in violation of F.S.S. 872.06(2)

PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT
