On the above date and time, I was responding to 20082 Palm Island Dr., in unincorporated Boca Raton FL, 33498 in reference to a possible attempted residential burglary, later reclassified to vehicle theft.
 Prior to arrival, PBSO Dispatch advised that the complainant stated he was currently with a subject, later identified as Jose Ordenez (suspect) and wanted him trespassed from the community. The complainant then advised he followed the subject to the community guard gatehouse and awaited for Law Enforcement to arrive. While waiting for Deputies, the subject then began to run around and suddenly took Cambridge Securities Community patrol vehicle (which had company marking on the outside) and headed Northbound from the community on Cain Rd.

Moments later, D/S J. Borja 17624 located a vehicle matching the description of the above-mentioned vehicle, crashed into tree, at the intersection of US Hwy 441 and Clint Moore Rd in the North West corner of the intersection. All of the vehicles doors were closed and its sole occupant was sitting in the driver seat of the vehicle. The driver of the vehicle was then removed from the vehicle and placed into handcuffs by Agent _____

Palm Beach County Fire Rescue (PBCFR) responded and evaluated Jose Ordenez for his injuries in reference to the crash, reference PBSO case# 23-135150.

A show-up was then conducted by Sgt. Greene 5539 with the witness/complainant, later identified as Zaine Gillock, which yielded positive ID to suspect, Jose Ordenez as the person who took the Cambridge Security Community Patrol vehicle without permission. After the Show-up Jose Ordenez was then transported to West Boca Medical Hospital by PBCFR reference PBCFR case# 23-144016 Rescue #53.

I then conducted a sworn video recorded statement interview with the witness/complainant, Mr. Zaine Gillock, who stated the following not verbatim: On today's date during the evening hours, the community security company (Cambridge Security) was contacted by a resident, who advised there was a white male outside his residence and he was scared. Upon the complainant/witness arriving at 20082 Palm Island Dr, he conducted a perimeter search and when he returned to the front, he observed a white male, Jose Ordenez, standing outside the residence. While attempting to talk to Jose Ordenez, Jose suddenly told Mr. Gillock "he tried to rob this house." Based on Ordenez statement to him, Mr. Gillock then attempted to separate Ordenez from the residence and followed him to the community guard gatehouse. Mr. Gillock followed Mr. Ordenez in his vehicle as Mr. Ordenez walked in front of his vehicle. Upon arriving at the Community guard gatehouse, located at 10700 Point Royal Dr, Boca Raton, FL 33498, Mr. Gillock parked the vehicle on the exit side of the gatehouse. After parking the Cambridge Security community patrol vehicle outside the community gate, Mr. Gillock exited the vehicle, while leaving the vehicle unlocked, running with the keys in the ignition switch, and the driver window partially down. Both Mr. Gillock and Mr. Ordenez then talked in the rear of the vehicle as Mr. Ordenez was sitting down. Mr. Gillock then attempted to provide his partner and PBSO dispatch with the description of the suspect, at which point Mr. Ordenez took off his shirt and "changed his whole demeanor." Mr. Ordenez suddenly got up and ran towards the guest and resident entrance lanes and it appeared Mr. Ordenez was attempting to get into a vehicle. Mr. Gillock then began to yell at Mr. Ordenez to get away from the vehicles of the guest/residents area who were attempting to enter the community. Mr. Ordenez then approached a White Subaru sedan. Mr. Gillock stated it appeared Mr. Ordenez was about to open the door, when it opened. As the door opened, Mr. Gillock once again, yelled at Mr. Ordenez at which point the Subaru's door closed. Mr. Gillock was then able to get Mr. Ordenez to sit down near the entrance side. While Mr. Ordenez was sitting, Mr. Ordenez suddenly got up and ran towards another vehicle but was unable to enter the vehicle. Mr. Ordenez then ran towards the Cambridge Securities Community patrol vehicle and entered the vehicle. While Mr. Ordenez was inside the vehicle, he then placed the vehicle in drive and began to drive. As Mr. Ordenez fled with the vehicle, Mr. Gillock was able to grab a hold of the steering wheel of the vehicle, attempting to stop Mr. Ordenez, but then let go when he noticed he was losing control of the situation, causing Mr. Gillock to fall. Mr. Gillock observed Mr. Ordenez drove Northbound on Cain Rd after exiting the community. The Sworn video-recorded statement was obtained using my agency assigned body worn camera (BWC) and Agency in-car camera from vehicle asset number 79725.

Mr. Gillock described the suspect as a white/Hispanic male, approximately 6'2", wearing Black top with foreign, non-English lettering, black pants, and black shoes. Let it be noted, Mr. Ordenez did not have permission to enter or drive the Cambridge Security Community patrol vehicle.

Based on the above investigation, I find probable cause to charge Jose Ordenez for Grand Theft Auto, contrary to F.S.S. 812.014(2c6).
